Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Oral/poster presentations encompassing one or more topics of the conference theme will be prioritized:

The BIG Three: Climate Change, Introduced Species, & Eutrophication

Solutions from Traditional Knowledge and Western Science Perspectives on Lake Stewardship

- Speakers will be allocated 20 minute time slots with an additional 10 minutes for questions.
- We encourage abstract submissions for poster sessions as well. All posters will be displayed at the conference.
- **Abstracts are due by May 31, 2023.**
- Submit abstracts to info@bclss.org. Abstracts must include the following information, as specified.
 - **Title:** Accurately summarize the subject of the presentation.
 - **Keywords:** Provide no more than three (3) one- or two-word keywords for your presentation such as Climate Change, Introduced Species, Eutrophication, etc.
 - **Authors:** Provide names and affiliations of all authors.
 - **Text:** State the purpose, significant findings, and main conclusions of the work. Abstracts must not exceed 250 words. Abstracts selected for either oral or poster presentations will be available to conference attendees.
 - **Format:** Indicate your presentation preference (oral, poster, or either).
